INDIE Following the critical acclaim for his new album *Love It To Life*, **Jesse Malin** and his new band **The St. Marks Social** will play **Norwich Arts Centre** on Saturday (8pm). After three well-received solo records, world tours and TV appearances, Malin found himself back in New York City. From his days fronting seminal hardcore trio **Heart Attack** and infamous glam punks **D Generation**, then seven years on the road as a solo artist, Malin had cultivated a devoted fan base. Over the summer of 2009, the songs came forth for what would become *Love It To Life*. Malin, with impresario **Don DiLeGo**, drummer **Randy Schrage**, guitarist **Matt Hogan**, and bassist **DJ Tommy USA**, bashed out an album's worth of gritty anthems, and **The St. Marks Social** was born.
